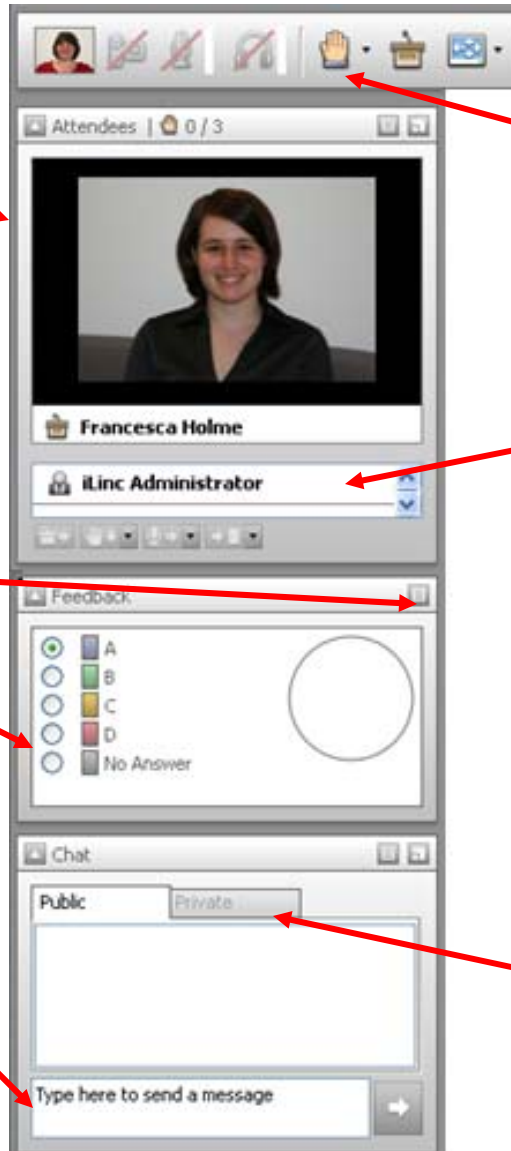
Presentation Area

Toolbar

Presenter

This window displays an image of the presenter or floor holder, i.e., the person who currently has control of the iLinc meeting.



Raise Hand

Click the hand raise button to get the attention of the presenter.

Attendees

The names of all meeting attendees appear in the Attendees list. Presenters and Assistants (in bold) will be able to see a hand icon next to an attendee's name when they have a question. Double-click on a person's name to give them control of the iLinc meeting.

Feedback

The current floor holder can on the Feedback settings button and select a question type to poll all attendees.

Text Chat

Type a message in the box and click **Send**. This is how you can communicate with others during the session. Public text chat messages are seen by everyone.

Private Text Chat

Click the Private tab to send a private text chat message to another attendee.

Presentation Area

The presentation area is where the meeting leader will display content. Content could include PowerPoint slides, web pages, an electronic whiteboard, or application sharing. When several content items have been opened, you will see them listed as tabs along the top of the presentation area. Presenters and Assistants can open content for all meeting attendees

Content Tab: Click the Content tab to open your PowerPoint presentations.

Application Sharing: Share your desktop or an open application (e.g., Word document or Acrobat PDF) with everyone

Synchronized Browser: This tool opens a web browser in a new tab. The presenter can go to a web site and all participants will see the web page.
